THE MEMORIAL SERVICE FOR PRIVATE MARTIN VAN BUREN MCQUIGG, A SOLDIER KILLED AT THE BATTLE OF WILSON'S CREEK, WILL TAKE PLACE AT BRICK CHURCH (ANTIOCH) CEMETERY NORTHWEST OF SPRINGFIELD.

Commander Travis Archie announced today that the Campbell's Company Camp #2252 of the Sons of Confederate Veterans will be having a memorial service and headstone dedication for Private Martin Van Buren McQuigg on Saturday October 22nd, 2016 at 11 A.M.

Private McQuigg served in the Missouri State Guard (C.S.A.) in Captain Leonidas S.C. Campbell's Company of Cavalry composed of men from the Springfield area. He was mortally wounded at the Battle of Wilson's Creek and died at some point on August 10th, 1861. His eight month pregnant wife rode to the battlefield to recover him and according to firsthand accounts family and comrades buried him in Brick Church Cemetery that night. His grave has remained unmarked for over 150 years.

Various dignitaries of the local historical community will be present to commemorate this event. Reenactors will also be on site to deliver a musket and artillery salute. The general public is cordially invited to take part in this near once-in-a-lifetime historic event.

Seating will be limited so the public is encouraged to bring lawn chairs if sitting is required.

The event is rain or shine so bring an umbrella if the weather calls for it.

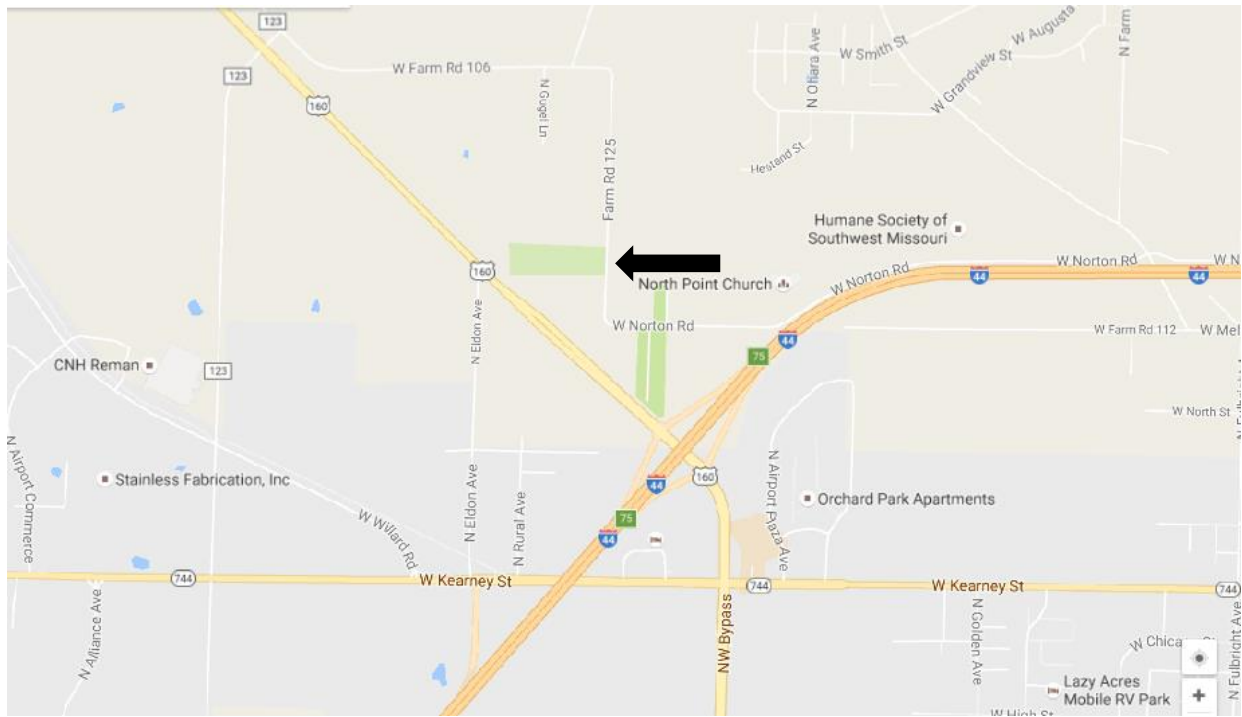
The ceremony will take around an hour.

Brick Church Cemetery is located a couple of miles northwest of Springfield on North Farm Road 125.

From I-44 take exit 75 US 160 (West Bypass) / Willard and take a right (North). Make the first right or (East) on Farm Road 123 and make an immediate right (southeast) at the T (Farm Road 106). Follow the road until it makes a sharp turn to the right (South) and turns into Farm Road 125. Right before the road makes a sharp turn to the left (east) the cemetery will be on the right.
