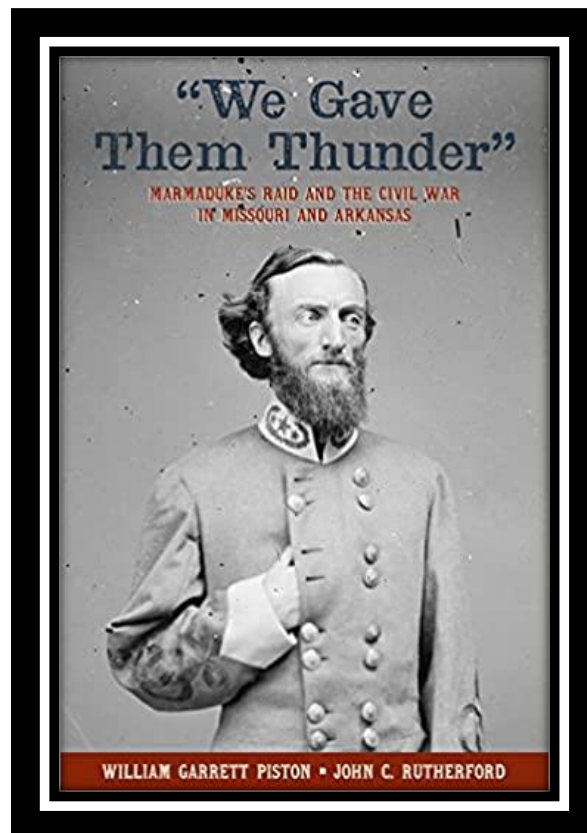

Guest speaker, member Tim Noonan, portrayed William Blackwood Gordan, one of his Civil War ancestors.

It was a most entertaining presentation. Tim was in period costume and along with an authentic accent and staying in character of the times provided a very real sense that we were indeed in the presence of the Old Rebel himself. His power point with lots of pictures of buildings, houses, maps, and military scenes, provided a lot of visual information as well.
